As part of our Humanities unit next term, we will be studying the Anglo-Saxons. To immerse the children in their topic, and to develop their historical skills further, we have planned a trip to Bishops Wood Centre, Stourport on Severn on Friday 27th April 2018.

The trip will take place within the school day, departing after registration and returning before 3.15pm. The day has been tailor-made to suit the children's topic and they will have the opportunity to explore artefacts, investigate Saxon village life and jobs in the Saxon Hall, take part in creating some Anglo-Saxon art and also learn more about the Battle of Hastings. It will be a very active and fun filled day, bringing the Saxon times to life!

Please make sure that children dress in clothing and footwear appropriate for the weather. It is difficult to predict what this might be; however, programmes will continue in all weathers. Please note that some of the activities will be held outside.
