Dear Parents and Carers

Exciting residential visit to Pioneer Centre!

As we eagerly prepare for the next academic year, we would like to take this opportunity to invite all new Year 5 pupils on an exciting residential trip for 2 nights during the autumn term: Wednesday 13th – Friday 15th November 2019.

We will be staying at the Pioneer Centre in Cleobury Mortimer, Shropshire, who offer a range of team building challenges, which we feel will strengthen the overall transition process. Current Y5 pupils thoroughly enjoyed the trip last November and gained some long lasting memories of the activities they took part in. Although the final cost for the trip is yet to be confirmed (taking into consideration the costings per pupil and the coach), **the total cost for the previous academic year was £130** which included the transport to Shropshire and the Pioneer Centre charges. We anticipate that this year's total cost will be similar and will confirm this with you in due course.

We will be asking for a deposit of £50. Details of how to pay for this will be provided in September. This must be paid via the Parent Pay portal. Although you will not be able to pay for this until September, we have sent home your personal login details with your child today. The final balance would then be due by Monday 14th October 2019 to enable us to pay the Pioneer Centre.

For Pupil Premium pupils, the cost of the trip will be subsidised by £50 but we do ask that the specified deposit is still paid.

We will be arranging an Information Evening for parents (children very welcome too) and we will provide more information about this in September.
